WELCOME!

- ★ The FLLJr program provides an opportunity for students in Kindergarten through Third Grade to participate in a fun after-school program designed to promote interest in science and technology.
- ★ Students will learn basic design and researching skills as they learn about a real-world topic, build a LEGO model, and create a poster about what they learned and their experience. This year the theme involves WATER.
- ★ Teams typically take a field trip as part of their research. Fun!!
- ★ The program's basic tenets include hands-on experience, fun, teamwork, and recognition of all participants.
- ★ Teams are directed by adult volunteers, usually parents.

Teams

FLLJr Official Guidelines: Teams may have 3 to 6 students ages 6-10. (Age as of 1-1-18)
In our program, K to 3rd-graders may participate. Kindergarten students: parent should be a coach or assistant coach & student should be mature enough.

- *Team Meeting Guide for Coaches

Teams will provide:

- +Two adults to register and serve as Coach and Assistant Coach.
- +Mentor (optional, but strongly recommended)
- +Place to meet
- +Poster materials
- +Optional additional LEGO pieces
- +A minimum of one volunteer to assist with the EXPO on May 5
- +Enthusiasm!

- PVEF-sponsored teams will have Camarillo public school students as team members. Although they may be organized by school, these are not official school activities. The team members do not all have to attend the same school.

- Teams will meet once or twice a week for approximately 10 weeks. Meeting places and times will vary. Each team will set its own schedule.
- One or two adults must register for each team at www.pvef.org and then complete a brief online background check through FIRST for the team to become official. Co-coaches are OK and encouraged. Individual team members register after their coaches have established the team.
